UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON FRAMEWORK PLAN

The University of Houston's Campus Framework Plan was completed in 2006 by Cooper Robertson & Partners. The plan established an overall design direction for the campus. In 2008 UH selected Clark Condon Associates as part of a multi disciplinary design team to implement portions of the framework. Clark Condon's proven ability to work on a multi disciplinary design team with projects of varied scales was a key factor in being chosen for the project. Immediate planning and design needs for the University include integrating METRO light rail service into the campus framework, coordination of shuttle bus and parking circulation for the campus, and integration of proposed Multi Modal Transit Centers on the campus.

One of our initial tasks was to develop a corridor that will coordinate with METRO, City of Houston, Texas Southern University, University of Houston and the Third Ward Community to create a safe and inviting destination, attractive civic features, and a lasting source of community. This included landscape beautification, pedestrian walkways, roadway improvements and careful design and development of METRO's transit lines and stations. Services include the continuation of landscape design in connection with the Scott Street Corridor Project which encompasses 18 blocks of Scott from the Gulf Freeway/I-45 Interchange on the North to Wheeler Street on the south (1.3 miles). In addition to the corridor (the public realm) the study will include four special nodes which feature the Gulf Freeway Gateway, Elgin, Alabama Square and the Wheeler Gateway.
