

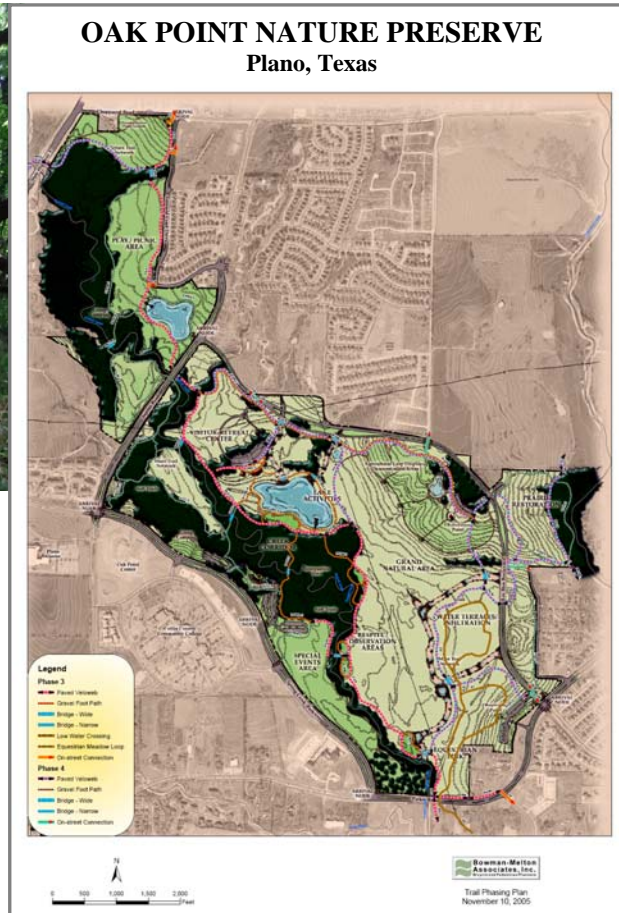
BMA PROJECT PROFILE

Oak Point Park and Nature Preserve Master Plan – Plano, TX



Bowman-Melton assisted Carter Burgess in regional, state and national benchmarking and site evaluation, and led the determination of corridor alignments interweaving throughout the bottomland hardwood forest, the mown meadows, and Rowlett Creek’s riverine environments encompassing Plano’s 630-acre Oak Point Park & Nature Preserve. The trail network planning considered current and future programming for the park’s new amphitheater and expansion of events centered around the annual Balloon Festival.

The resulting trail system includes 8.6 miles of decomposed granite soft-surface nature trails consistent with the City’s intent to expand its nature-based resources; and 7.6 miles of paved multiuse spine trails, which includes the Six Cities Trail Plan’s Plano connection, part of the NCTCOG Regional Veloweb system.
