SETRPC Transit Services

The South East Texas Regional Planning Commission (SETRPC) - Metropolitan Planning Organization (SETRPC-MPO) is the federally designated agency for the three-county area consisting of Jefferson, Orange and Hardin counties. The purpose of the MPO is to coordinate regional transportation planning among the State, counties, and cities within the JOHRTS area.

SETRPC is involved in the management of South East Texas Transit which is a rural transportation system that provides curb-to-curb demand/response transportation service for healthcare, shopping, social services, employment, education, and recreational needs. South East Texas Transit, together with other private and public transportation services in the area, is available to provide citizens with suitable and reliable means of transportation.

Explanation of Icons



General Purpose – Curb to curb transportation where transit provider will pick client up in front of their home or a designated pick-up location and provide transportation to and from any location. These trips are for any purpose travel including healthcare, shopping, social services, employment, education and recreational needs and are not limited to specific clientele.



Medical – Curb to curb transportation specifically for medical trips which include hospitals, doctor's offices, dialysis, and pharmacy visits. Transportation not restricted to the elderly or disabled depending on the provider. Some income and/or eligibility requirements may apply.



Medicaid – Curb to curb transportation for qualified Medicaid clients that have no other means of transportation. Transportation can be for medical or general purpose travel depending on the provider.



Senior/Disability – Curb to curb transportation provided for senior citizens and persons with disabilities. Transportation can be for medical or general purpose travel depending on the provider. Some income and/or eligibility requirements may apply.



Public Transit – Fixed route bus service located in Beaumont and Port Arthur. Private transportation providers can coordinate drop off of client to connect with public transit service at specific bus stops and transit centers.
